



# THE REAL COSTS OF THE SPAY NEUTER OPERATION



## What are the costs of operation at the Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic of the Sandhills? (In units of surgery)

Each unit of surgery is valued through the following expenses:

- Professional services of the Veterinarian/Veterinary Technicians and Staff
- Medical supplies
- Drugs during and after surgery
- Building and equipment maintenance

- The average spay surgery costs \$120.00 or two units of surgery at \$60.00 per unit
- The larger the dog or cat the more expensive the cost of surgery for the Clinic
- Obese, pregnant, and females in heat, require additional units of surgery
