**HOW WE ARE DOING---AN UPDATE FROM CACF**

By the end of 2016 the Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic, Vass, NC will have performed 55,000+ surgeries. Companion Animal Clinic Foundation is pleased to report on the improvements provided through your donations and grants 2015-2016. Your continued support financially and through volunteer efforts are the key to the success of the Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic and Companion Animal Clinic Foundation's mission to reduce euthanasia through affordable spay/neuter.

Also significant to our success is the initiative taken by the veterinarians and staff at the Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic in Vass, NC. The SNVC was awarded a PetSmart@Charties grant in 2016 for specific categories of surgery which enhanced their ability to expand service to the community. This grant provided surgery for puppies, kittens, feral cats, and support for individuals with financial need in a three month period spring/summer 2016.

Coupled with direct funding efforts by the Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic, the Foundation continues to support the SNVC through fundraising, grants and individual donations. Good progress has been made for the financial future of affordable spay/ neuter. With the mortgage pay off in January 2016 on the Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic building more funds for capital improvements and support were possible. Since the initial remodel of the par 3 golf shop into the Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic (2005-2007) service has been expanded from nine counties to eleven counties. Capital improvements (2008-2016) include adding a third surgery room and equipment, new roof, insulation to the attic with HVAC improvements, office and kitchen remodeling, painting, signage enhancements, and fencing of the back yard to secure intake for animal groups. At the same time maintenance, replacement, and enhancement of equipment continues in 2016 with grants from several national foundations, the Moore County Community Foundation, an event sponsored by Vision 4 Moore, and most importantly, our individual donors. Social media and website improvements have significantly improved communication and ease of use for our clients at the Clinic. The result is the continuation of affordable spay/neuter at the SNVC. We thank you for your past support and hope you will join us in our efforts as we improve and expand the facility and personnel, and continue to repair/replace equipment, well worn as we exceed 55,000 surgeries.

Our next fundraiser, *A Taste of Europe* will be October 25th, 6:00PM at the Wine Cellar & Tasting Room in Southern Pines. A display of original art and a donated trip will be available for auction.
